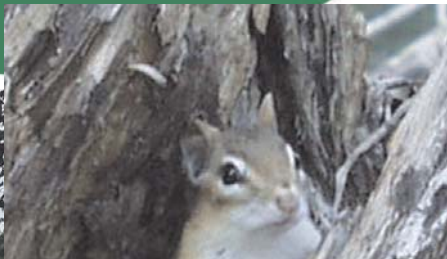

Moosehead Lake is the largest lake east of the Mississippi contained completely in one state. It's blue waters stretch as far as the eye can see until swallowed by the green of the surrounding forest. The Moosehead Lake Region is a perfect example of the explanation behind the state's motto of "Maine - the way life should be".

Located at the southern portion of Maine's great north woods, Moosehead Lake is saturated in history. Henry David Thoreau and his explorations with Indian guides in the mid-1800's speak about the North Woods of Maine in a way that is not too far from today's description of the same region. It is a fact that more moose live in the North Woods than anywhere else in New England. Escape the noise, crowds, and hustle and bustle of the big cities and rural areas and visit Greenville, Maine.



Beautiful mountains offer hiking experiences for all abilities (including a stretch of the Appalachian Trail), as well as bird watching, scenic vistas, mountain biking, skiing, snow boarding and ice climbing. And of course, some of the finest Moose watching in the country is right outside!

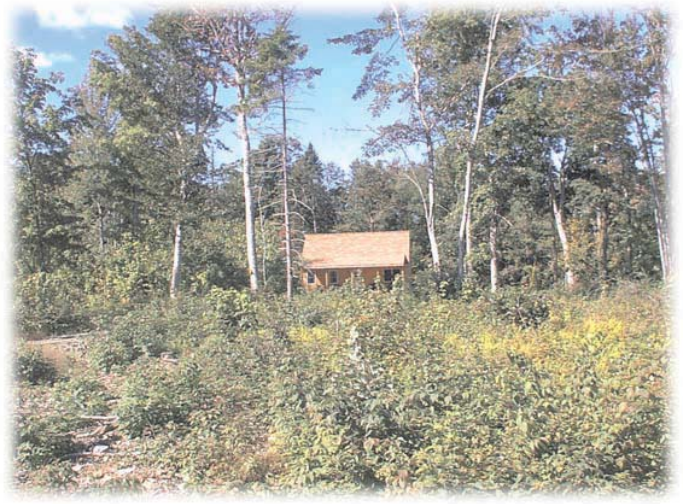

Public boat access is less than a mile for those that enjoy summer boating on Moosehead Lake's 20 mile by 40 mile clear, blue waters. There is plenty of fishing on Prong Pond, which is walking distance from the cabin.



Springtime offers a chance to see wildlife from birds, bear, fox, porcupine, and the mighty moose.



Fall is beyond written description. My daughter's comment the first October we spent in the Moosehead Lake region says it all when she stated, "I now know where Crayola gets all their ideas".

5 miles from town, this cabin gives you the privacy you can enjoy with the access to supplies you need. The town of Greenville is filled with gift shops, restaurants, and plenty of local hospitality.
